Rhode Island's single-family home sales continued to cool down in July, with closing activity falling year-over-year by 13.4 percent. Pending contracts not closed by the end of the month also dropped. Despite the slowdown, prices continue to rise due to low inventory, which showed no gains from the prior month.
